Hi Paul,

Waikato Regional Council has decided to undertake a review of consent conditions for the following consents held by the Whangamata Marina Society Inc:

Consent No	Purpose	Location
121398	To remove no more than 10,000 cubic metres per year of natural marine material from the bed of the Whangamata Harbour including associated vehicle use and stockpiling, for maintenance dredging purposes.	Whangamata Harbour
121399	Deposit up to 10,000 cubic metres per annum of clean sand on the foreshore of Whangamata harbour, including associated vehicle use, for beach nourishment purposes.	Whangamata Harbour

The review will be undertaken under section 128(1) of the Resource Management Act 1991 for the following purposes:

- (i) to review the effectiveness of the conditions of this resource consent in avoiding or mitigating any adverse effects on the environment from the exercise of this resource consent and if necessary to avoid, remedy or mitigate such effects by way of further or amended conditions; or
- (ii) if necessary and appropriate, to require the holder of this resource consent to adopt the best practicable option to remove or reduce adverse effects on the surrounding environment; or
- (iii) to review the adequacy of and the necessity for monitoring undertaken by the consent holder.

I appreciate your and EDS' offer to hold a workshop to reach a common understanding on the physical processes that are occurring. At this stage I do not consider that a workshop is required. WRC recognises your concerns from previous meetings, correspondence and your recently submitted report. However, if you wish to provide further scientific information which may assist the review process, please do so.
